



APPLICATION PROCEDURE

In order to be considered for admission the following is required for all applicants:

1. Original transcripts and High School Diploma that must be accompanied by notarized translation into Serbian and validated by the Ministry of Education of the Republic of Serbia (22-26 Nemanjina Street, Belgrade);
2. Birth certificate and notarized translation into Serbian;
3. Demonstration of competence in English language;
4. The filled out application form. The application form can be downloaded from the web-site. It is available at the Office of Students Affairs too.

To begin the application procedure, please e-mail the required documents (1-4) and the proof of payment of the application fee.

However, for the registration the original documents are required. They have to be submitted to:

1ST ADMISSION PERIOD

JULY 12-13, 2010: deadline for submission of original documents.

JULY 15, 2010: entry exam (Biology and Chemistry tests) and an interview.

JULY 16, 2010: enrollment.

2ND ADMISSION PERIOD

SEPTEMBER 20-22, 2010: deadline for submission of original documents.

SEPTEMBER 24, 2010: entry exam (Biology and Chemistry tests) and an interview.

SEPTEMBER 27-30, 2010: enrollment

TUITION AND FEES

Current tuition fee is US\$ 7000 per academic year.

The BUSM Studies in English does have a program to accept students wishing to transfer from other medical schools. The Committee on Admissions gives preference to candidates who present the strongest scholastic records.

ABOUT SCHOOL

The **BELGRADE UNIVERSITY SCHOOL OF MEDICINE (BUSM)**, founded in 1920, is the largest institution for training of physicians in Serbia as well as in Balkan region, and the **UNIVERSITY OF BELGRADE** is the oldest (1905) and largest one in the region with another 29 Faculties beside the Medical School and 80,000 students.

In the **BUSM**, clinical training and research are attached to the Clinical Center of Serbia and several large and highly specialized hospitals. The BUSM includes some 40 departments with about 200 professorships. A close linkage between graduate and postgraduate work and research ensures high academic standards.

The BUSM also offers: residency programs, internships and fellowships for a broad spectrum of specialties, a wide range of programs for a degree of Doctor of Biomedical Sciences, and continuing medical education programs for physicians and other health care professionals.

By the appointment of the Ministry of Health of the Republic of Serbia, as the integral part of BUSM, with the same curriculum approved by the authorities and recognized by the international medical associations, in 1995, English was introduced as a language of instruction. That was the beginning of **BELGRADE UNIVERSITY SCHOOL OF MEDICINE - STUDIES IN ENGLISH**.

The course of instruction leading to the M.D. degree- Doctor of Medicine - extends over a six year period (12 semesters) which correspond to 360 ECTS.

SELECTION STANDARDS

GENERAL QUALIFICATIONS. BUSM Studies in English selects applicants who in the judgment of the Committee on Admissions demonstrate those qualities necessary for the successful study and practice of medicine. Among others, these qualities include academic achievement, good communication skills, emotional stability, maturity, diversity of interests, leadership, and motivation. The Committee considers the quality of all academic accomplishments of each applicant, as well as extracurricular experiences that demonstrate the applicant's initiative and creativity.

School of Medicine in its admission practice complies with federal nondiscrimination laws relating to national origin, religion, citizenship, race, sex, age, and handicap that do not compromise professional responsibilities.

SPECIFIC REQUIREMENTS. The qualifications required for admission to the BUSM Studies in English are evidence of intellectual ability and achievement, indicated by performance in high school courses and evaluations examinations, and suitable personal qualities as to character, attitude and interest.

A prospective medical student must have a good foundation in general education, including chemistry, physical sciences, and biomedical sciences. Course work must include the following subjects:

- ◆ Biology (with lab)..... 1 year
- ◆ General chemistry (with lab)..... 1 year
- ◆ Organic chemistry (with lab)..... 1 year
- ◆ Physics (with lab)..... 1 year
